

Joining the data-science-nights.org Slack team

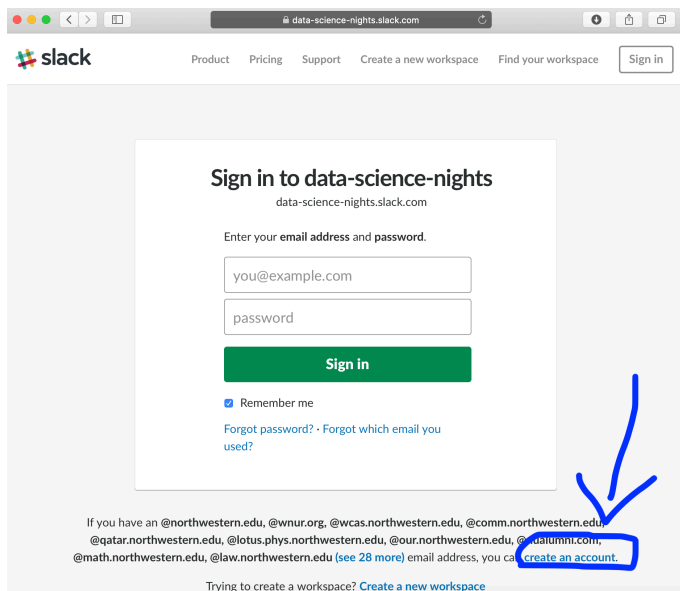
Slack is a software, which you can use to chat with other participants of the Data Science Nights. This guide illustrates how to set up an account and start using Slack.

Registering an account

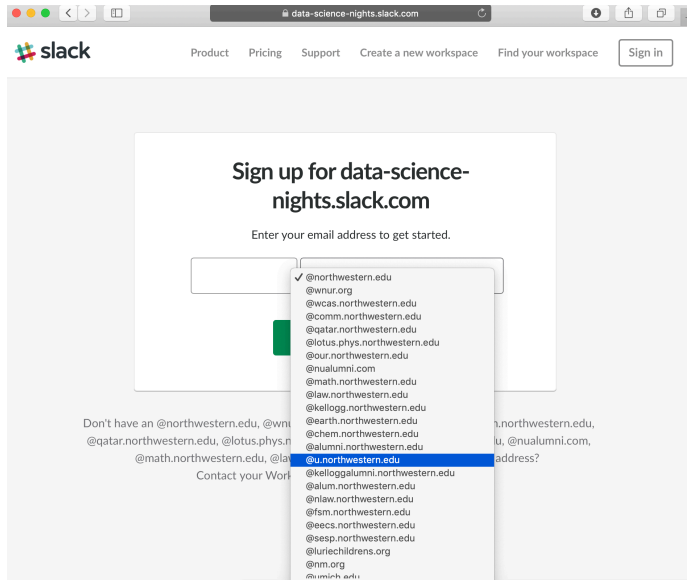
Go to data-science-nights.slack.com.

If you do not yet have registered a Slack account for data-science-nights.slack.com you will need to create one. *Note: distinct Slack teams will need separate Slack accounts. For instance, if you would already be using Slack for example-research-group.slack.com, you would still need to register for data-science-nights.slack.com*

To create an account for data-science-nights.slack.com click onto the “create an account” link in the bottom right corner of the screen.



Now create an account with your Northwestern email address. You might have to use the drop-down menu to select an entry different from “northwestern.edu”, e.g.: “u.northwestern.edu” or “kellogg.northwestern.edu”. *If you do not have a Northwestern email account, write a one-sentence mail to chaperones@data-science-nights.org, and we will invite you to our Slack team.*



Once you have registered an account, you will receive an email from Slack with further directions. Usually it contains a link that will allow you to log into Slack through your browser.
